

## Monthly Case Summary

- A 22 year old male was arrested after making verbal threats to a family member.
- A 42 year old female was arrested for domestic violence after a physical disturbance.
- Officers responded to a report of a shoplifter. Upon arrival it was determined that the suspect assaulted the store clerk. A 16 year old male was arrested for burglary and assault.
- A 31 year old male was arrested for domestic violence after a physical disturbance.
- A customer at Starbucks reported a theft of a laptop. An unknown subject approached the victim, grabbed the laptop, and fled the area. This case is currently under investigation.
- A maintenance worker was reportedly shot in the leg with a pellet gun while working in an apartment complex. This case is under investigation.
- Officers responded to a report of a burglary at Rite-Aid. Four suspects entered the store and left with approximately \$1,100 worth of merchandise. This case is currently under investigation.
- A local business received an online order totaling \$9,000, the business determined the order was made with a stolen credit card. This case is currently under investigation.
