### Alcohol Compliancy Checks



## Monthly Case Summary

- A 29 year old male was arrested for domestic violence and warrant charges out of Napa County after assaulting his wife.
- Officers responded with Benicia Fire Department to a report of a possible arson in the playground at St. Dominic's School. This case is currently under investigation.
- A 49 year old male was arrested without incident for failure to register as a sex offender.
- Officers responded to a report of a vehicle driving erratically. It was determined that the vehicle hit a pole, causing damage. The vehicle was located parked in front of a nearby residence. A 21 year old male was contacted and arrested for driving under the influence, hit and run, and assault on an officer.
- A vehicle burglary occurred in which the victim was able to provide a description of the suspects and their vehicle. The vehicle was located and contact was made. A 48 year old male and a 50 year old female were arrested for probation violation and possession of stolen property. A 29 year old female was arrested for possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of stolen property, and committing a felony crime while out on bail.
- A 43 year old male was arrested without incident for battery with serious injury.
- A 36 year old male was arrested without incident for violation of a restraining order.
