

Monthly Case Summary

- Armed robbery occurred at Nexcycle Recycle Center. An undisclosed amount of money was taken and there were no injuries. There is one suspect outstanding. This case is currently under investigation.
- A 19 year old male was arrested without incident for possession of stolen property and driving on a suspended license following a routine traffic stop.
- A 22 year old male was arrested without incident for receiving stolen property, forgery, 2 counts of burglary, and an outstanding robbery warrant after an investigation.
- Following an investigation, officers served a search warrant in which a 29 year old male was arrested without incident for 13 counts of check fraud, 3 counts of identity theft, and possession of drug paraphernalia. A 30 year old male was also arrested without incident for 6 counts of possession of forged documents and 2 counts of identity theft.
- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance. Upon arrival a 27 year old male was arrested without incident for burglary, restraining order violation, and probation violation.

- Corporal Criado and Officer Menesini completed a 40 hour Officer Safety and Field Tactics Course.
