Family Resource Center

Alcohol Compliancy Checks

- In partnership with Friday Night Live, BPD conducted a minor decoy shoulder tap operation at various locations throughout Benicia. The minor decoy stood in front of 8 different establishments that sell alcoholic beverages and approached adults, asking them if they would purchase alcohol. A 22 year old male, a 50 year old female, and two 26 year old males were arrested for furnishing alcohol to a minor.



Monthly Case Summary

- A 33 year old male and a 27 year old female were arrested without incident for possession of a controlled substance, transportation of a controlled substance, possession of narcotic paraphernalia, and possession of a hypodermic needle following a routine traffic stop.
- A 27 year old male was arrested without incident for criminal threats, stalking, violation of a restraining order, and probation violation after it was reported that he violated a restraining order.
- A male subject was contacted and found to be in possession of several pieces of mail not belonging to him. Upon investigation an 18 year old male was arrested without incident for possession of stolen property and possession of drug paraphernalia. A 19 year old male was also arrested for possession of stolen property and an outstanding warrant for vehicle theft.
- Officers responded to a report of a family disturbance in which the suspect was armed with a knife. Upon arrival a 21 year old male was contacted and arrested without incident for robbery and criminal threats.
- Officers responded to multiple reports of shots fired on the freeway. Officers received reports that two suspects fled the area. After an extensive area search with assistance from neighboring agencies and the SWAT team, the case was turned over to CHP.
