### Family Resource Center



## Monthly Case Summary

- Officers were dispatched on a report of 2 subjects smoking possible drugs. Officers contacted both men and subsequently arrested them for possession of stolen property, possession of methamphetamine, possession of drug paraphernalia, ID fraud, forgery and a probation violation.
- Officers responded to a call from an off duty SFPD officer who advised he was holding a burglary suspect at gunpoint that he found in his apartment. The 23 year old male Vallejo resident was arrested for burglary and possession of stolen property.
- Officers responded to a call regarding a suspicious vehicle and person not familiar to the area. Officers contacted a 25 year old male subject in the vehicle, who was found to have a felony warrant for burglary. It was later determined that the vehicle was stolen out of Alameda. Officers charged the subject with possession of stolen property and stolen vehicle, possession of marijuana and a violation of probation.
