Here are some pictures of the area where the three grenades were found. My escort took the pictures because they have a policy that you need specific permission to take pictures within their facility boundaries. They were taken at the former process water evaporation ponds located near the crude oil storage tanks. As you can see, Valero is in the process of building some new crude oil storage tanks within the boundaries of the old ponds. The road we were standing on when we took the pictures was recently installed. Graders were used to make the road and spread the road base. Then laborers raked the sides of the road to even it out. That is how the grenade was found. It appears that the grader dislodged the grenade and moved it to the side of the road. The other two grenades were found several months earlier in the bottom of the pond near the large rocks. Essentially, the three grenades were found in the same general area. I ran the schonstedt around the area where the rocks are and up the wall of the pond and found no anomalies.

As you probably already know, the landscape contractors were not planting bushes on the day I was there. I asked Ted Splitter if they were going to be working late in the afternoon on Thursday. He contacted the contractor who said that they would probably be finished with their work by the time I got there (around 4:00 PM). Accordingly, I couldn't take any pictures of them planting the bushes.






J.Pey from DTSC files - location of OE find at Valero property


Jpeg from DTSC files - locations of OE finds at Valero property
