

Monthly Case Summary

- A 49 year old male was arrested for possession of a controlled substance after a routine traffic stop.
- A 39 year old male was arrested for possession of a controlled substance, possession of drug paraphernalia, providing false identification, probation violation, and two no bail warrant charges after a routine traffic stop.
- A 29 year old female was arrested for possession of a controlled substance, possession of drug paraphernalia, and a probation violation after a routine traffic stop.
- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious person. Upon contact it was determined that the subject was a suspect in a recent burglary. A 45 year old male was arrested without incident for burglary and possession of stolen property.
- A 56 year old male was arrested without incident for resisting an officer and public intoxication.
- A 15 year old male was arrested for threats and battery.
- A commercial burglary was reported at Rite-Aid. Electronics items were taken and the suspects fled in an unknown vehicle. The case is currently under investigation.
