

## Monthly Case Summary

- A 15 year old male and a 16 year old male were arrested for fighting on school grounds after a physical disturbance at Benicia High School.
- A 21 year old male was arrested for public intoxication and a 25 year old male was arrested for a probation violation after a disturbance at Bottom Of The Fifth.
- Officers responded to a call of a suspicious subject in the area of Park Road. Upon arrival a male was contacted and a consent search was conducted of his vehicle. It was determined that the subject was a suspect in recent arsons. The 23 year old male was arrested without incident for attempt arson and two charges of arson.
- A 54 year old man was arrested without incident for assault with a deadly weapon and driving under the influence after he attempted to hit a friend with his vehicle.
- Officers responded to Liberty High School to investigate threats that were made by a student. Upon arrival, a male subject ran from the school and was located by two additional officers in the area. Upon contact of the subject a firearm was located. A 17 year old male was arrested without incident for possession of a firearm on school grounds, minor in possession of a firearm, threats, and five additional weapons violations charges.
- Officers responded to a family disturbance. A 39 year old female was arrested without incident for assault and threats.
- A 24 year old male was arrested without incident for receiving stolen property, possession of drug paraphernalia, probation violation, possession of a controlled substance, and weapons charges after a routine traffic stop.
