

## Monthly Case Summary

- Officers responded to a report of a robbery at the Bank of America ATM in the Southampton Shopping Center. The victim, a 59 year old female Benicia resident, was punched in the face after refusing to give the suspect her ATM card. Suspect, a Hispanic male 25-30 years old fled in a black sedan on Southampton Road.
- Officers responded to a report of a physical altercation in City Park. Officers located a 44 year old male down with minor injuries, and arrested a 33 year old male for the battery.
- A 22 year old female was arrested without incident for hit and run, driving under the influence and possession of a controlled substance, after officers were dispatched to a report of a traffic accident
- Officers responded to a report of a solo vehicle traffic accident. A 48 year old male was arrested for driving under the influence and resisting arrest.
- Officers responded to a report of a male subject spitting in victim's face when they refused to buy alcohol for him. The 24 year old male was taken into custody for assault, drunk in public, resisting arrest and probation violations.
- Officers responded to a report of an accident with the vehicle in a ditch. The driver, a 50 year old male was not injured and inadvertently stepped on the gas instead of the brake while attempting to park.
