### Movie In The Park


- Department Volunteers assisted with the Movie In The Park on August 16th.

## Monthly Case Summary

- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance. A 31 year old male was contacted and arrested without incident for domestic violence.
- A 60 year old male was arrested without incident for possession of a loaded firearm and concealing a firearm following a routine traffic stop.
- A 27 year old male was arrested on five counts of attempt assault with a deadly weapon after driving his vehicle towards another person during a dispute.
- Officers responded to a report of a family disturbance. A 17 year old female was arrested for vandalism.
- A 52 year old male was arrested for a court order violation after violating a restraining order.
- A 31 year old male was contacted on a routine traffic stop and found to be driving a stolen vehicle. The male was arrested for vehicle theft, receiving stolen property, possession of a controlled substance, and transporting a controlled substance.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic collision. Upon arrival a 25 year old male was contacted and arrested without incident for driving under the influence.
- A 21 year old female was arrested without incident for assault following a family disturbance.
- An 18 year old male was arrested for possession of a controlled substance and possession for sale after a routine traffic stop.
