Meeting Procedures

All items listed on this agenda are for discussion and/or action. In accordance with the Brown Act, each item is listed and includes, where appropriate, further description of the item and/or a recommended action. The posting of a recommended action does not limit, or necessarily indicate, what action may be taken.

Pursuant to Government Code Section 65009, if you challenge a decision of the Library Board in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Library Board at, or prior to, the public hearing. You may also be limited by the ninety (90) day statute of limitations in which to challenge in court certain administrative decisions and orders (Code of Civil Procedure 1094.6) to file and serve a petition for administrative writ of mandate challenging any final City decisions regarding planning or zoning.

Appeals of the Library Board decisions, which are final actions, not recommendations, are considered by the City Council. Appeals must be filed with the City Clerk in writing, stating the basis of appeal with the appeal fee within 10 days of the date of action.
