WORKSHOP PRESENTATION:

OVERVIEW OF THE MARINA AREA STORM DRAIN PROJECT INCLUDING THE ENGINEERING, ENVIRONMENTAL AND FINANCIAL ISSUES RELATED TO THE REPLACEMENT OF THE STORM DRAIN

Virgil Mustain, Public Works Director, made the presentation to the Council.

Questions were asked and comments made by the Mayor and Council Members.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Andee Leisy, Representative, Benicia Harbor Corporation, expressed concerns regarding the ongoing and permanent discharge into the Marina and the cumulative impact of contaminants; requested an Environmental Impact Report be done.

Tom Evans, Representative, Pointe Benicia Board of Directors, stated that the current drainage problem on B Street cannot be solved until the issue of the Storm Drain is resolved.

Patrick O'Leary, 195 East B Street, stated that a test of the water collected from B Street had shown high levels of coliform.
