Benicia High School Homecoming Events


- Police Department Officers and Volunteers assisted with the Homecoming Parade, Homecoming Football Game, and Homecoming Dance.

Monthly Case Summary

- A 32 year old male was arrested without incident for unlawful sexual intercourse with a minor, sexual battery, and violation of parole, after receiving a report regarding a sexual assault.
- A 35 year old male was arrested without incident for vehicle theft, probation violation, and possession of stolen property, after a vehicle stop in which the vehicle was determined to be stolen. Liquor from a recent theft was located inside of the trunk.
- Officers responded to The Best Western Inn on a report of counterfeit items being located and the occupant on scene requesting to retrieve the items. Upon arrival and further investigation of the incident a 30 year old female was arrested for 4 counts of forgery, 7 counts of possession of forged documents, 7 counts of manufacturing forged checks, 12 counts of identity theft, possession of a controlled substance, possession of marijuana for sale, possession of narcotic paraphernalia, and probation violations. A 41 year old male was arrested for interfering with a police officer, battery on a police officer, providing false information, and violation of parole. A 26 year old female was also arrested for felony warrant charges.
- Officers responded to a large fight in the parking lot of Bottom of the Fifth. A 31 year old male was arrested for battery and a probation violation. A 22 year old male was also arrested for battery, threats, and violation of parole.
- Officers responded to a report of a male subject who advised his family he was going to jump off of the Benicia Bridge. Officers were able to locate the male and talk him off of the ledge. The male was taken into protective custody.
