

**EXTENSION REQUEST: HISTORIC ARSENAL PARK PROPERTY WITHIN THE FORMER BENICIA ARSENAL, BENICIA, CALIFORNIA – IMMINENT AND SUBSTANTIAL ENDANGERMENT DETERMINATION AND REMEDIAL ACTION ORDER (DOCKET NO. I/SE RAO 13/14-008)**

Dear Ms. McLaughlin, Ms. Hansberry, and Mr. Potter:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has received a request for a third extension to the Imminent and Substantial Endangerment Determination and Remedial Action Order (Order) from the Historic Arsenal Park and the City of Benicia, both dated October 28, 2014. Any pending DTSC work to amend the Order should not impede timely completion of the scheduled items below.

DTSC grants this third extension request for 30 more days. Consequently, the new due dates for following tasks under the Order are

Task 6, Monthly Summary Reports (initial)	January 15, 2015

The above extension does not apply to interim measures to mitigate vapor intrusion into indoor air and to monitor the effectiveness of the mitigation measures. This vapor intrusion work plan submittal is due November 25, 2014.
