OVERVIEW:

The City of Benicia is pleased to announce that the State Office of Historic Preservation has awarded a \$25,000 grant to assist in the preparation of a historic context statement for the City. This grant has allowed the City to hire Page & Turnbull, a historic preservation consultant, to assist in the development of this context statement.

The historic context statement will discuss significant themes in the development of Benicia from its earliest days into the 1960s. It will also discuss the types of properties associated with those themes and identify their character defining features. This will provide a framework for evaluating resources for the National Register of Historic Places, California Register of Historical Resources, and local registration programs.

We look forward to a joint effort between the City, Page & Turnbull, the Historical Society, Historical Museum, and the public, to complete this important task.
