***P3a. Description:**

This hotel building was constructed in the Craftsman Bungalow style circa 1917-1919. However, the building has been altered from its original historic appearance but is still able to convey its significance as a contributor to the Benicia Downtown Historic District. Changes which could be restored include the application of stucco over brown shingle. Original windows have been replaced with plate glass. Porch and stair have been replaced with concrete slab and steps. The original style of the building continues to be apparent in its massing and form. The building should continue to contribute to the District.
