\*P3a. Description:

This is a single story, six unit apartment building which stretches horizontally along the west end of G Street. Sited on a slope the apartment units abut the sidewalk in the front and add a partial story at the rear. Although relatively unelaborated in design or ornamentation, the building appears to reference the southwest or Pueblo Revival style. Each of the units has a centered front entry symmetrically flanked by one-over-one double hung windows. The entry of each is set off by a low gabled porch roof supported on rustic brackets. The building has a flat roof with a parapet that steps up from the west to the east end every two units. The most distinctive element of the building is its stucco cladding which is laid over randomly placed bricks which provide visual interest and texture to the otherwise planer surface of the façade. Two arched openings in the façade provide access to exterior stairways that lead to the lower level at the rear of the building. There is a 1960s addition at the rear of the building which is sited along West Second Street.
