***P3a. Description:**

This residence was originally constructed as a front gable vernacular cottage circa mid-20th century. The building does not appear on the Sanborn Maps through 1942. The building is a very modest example of a minimal traditional house, a type of property that was constructed in large numbers circa WWII. This building is not a particularly good example of the property type and period. A small number of infill properties from this period are scattered in the downtown area and do not contribute to the architectural character or coherency of the Downtown Historic District, nor do they represent an important phase of downtown development.
