*P3a. Description:

Based on remnant evidence in the roof line and side windows and casements, this residence was originally constructed as Italianate cottage circa late 19th century. A residence of similar form appears on the 1891 Sanborn Map at the same location. It has been substantially altered from its original historic appearance and no longer conveys its significance as a contributor to the Benicia Downtown Historic District. Changes include complete alteration of original cladding, replacement of front elevation windows, removal of original porch and replacement with a gable roof, Spanish Style arched entry and an arched connected side gate, also in the Spanish Style. The building lacks integrity of design, materials, workmanship, association and feeling.
