## Monthly Case Summary

- An officer on viewed a traffic collision with minor injuries. The officer assisted with getting both vehicles moved and information exchanged between the drivers. Approximately 40 minutes later, the same officer was taking a theft report of tires and wheels taken off a vehicle at a automotive business. The officer was able to view security footage and recognized the suspect vehicle as one of the involved parties in the earlier accident. That vehicle also had tires in the back bed at the time of the accident. Officers responded to the suspects location and arrested a 33 year old male Benicia resident for grand theft and vandalism


