NOTIFICATION OF POSSIBLE FLARING - Non-Emergency:

The Valero Benicia refinery has notified the City of Benicia Fire Department that they are performing planned work on processing units as they shut down some equipment inside the refinery. During this process, which is expected to begin today and last several days, there may be visible, intermittent flaring, which is a necessary safety precaution that will be managed in accordance with Valero's Flare Minimization Plan.

Valero will continue to communicate with the Benicia Fire Department, Solano County, and Bay Area Air Quality Management District about the potential flaring activity during this period. Although it is not anticipated that there will be any community health impacts, the Benicia Fire Department will continue to monitor and stay in communications with Valero.

Any significant changes will be communicated to the public through additional community alerts.
