



# Level 2 Notification

January 12, 2021

**NOTIFICATION OF RELEASE (unplanned):**

**\*INFORMATION ONLY – NON-EMERGENCY**

Shortly after 7:00 AM today, January 12, 2021, the Valero Benicia Refinery notified the Benicia Fire Department that they had experienced a leak in the effluent line to their waste-water treatment plant. The line runs parallel to Sulfur Springs Creek and is not into flowing water. The leak has been stopped and proper clean up, notification, and mitigation procedures are being performed.

There is no threat to public safety. Fire personnel will continue to monitor the situation and will update the public if conditions change.
