

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) also received a request for a 60 day extension from Benicia Industries Inc. (BII), dated November 12, 2014. BII was added as a RP in the Amendment to the Order issued October 30, 2014. DTSC grants an extension to BII to allow them to review documents and confer with representatives of the other parties and DTSC. The new due dates for BII's compliance with the Order are:
