

**RESOLUTION NO. 23- 142**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENICIA CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE HOLDING OF A STATEWIDE PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION FOR THE ELECTION OF MEASURE A THE TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX (HOTEL) MEASURE AND MEASURE B, THE BENICIA SAFETY AND SERVICES MEASURE, AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO GENERAL LAW CITIES**

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of the laws relating to general law cities in the State of California, a Statewide Presidential Primary election will be held on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of March 2024, for the election of Measure A, the Transient Occupancy Tax Measure (Hotel Tax), and Measure B, the Benicia Public Safety and Essential Services Measure; and

**WHEREAS**, The Solano County Registrar of Voters has provided an estimate for the election at \$142,000; and

**WHEREAS**, The County has published an estimated cost of \$7.00 per registered voter for all primary elections; and

**WHEREAS**, there are currently 20,300 registered voters in the City of Benicia.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the City Council of the City of Benicia does hereby resolve, declare, determine, and order as follows:

1. Pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to general law cities within the State, there shall be, and there is hereby called and ordered held in the City of Benicia, on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of March 2024, a Statewide Presidential Primary Election of the qualified electors of the City for the purpose of electing Measure A and Measure B.
2. The polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that there are sufficient funds in the FY 2023-2024 in the election services budget.




