Workshop on Renewable Electricity Options & Community Choice Aggregation

When: Tuesday, September 9, 2014, 6:00 P.M.

Where: City Council Chambers, 250 East L Street, Benicia CA

Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) agencies purchase and/or develop clean electricity on behalf of residents, businesses, and municipal accounts. A CCA works with PG&E to deliver renewable energy, maintain the energy grid, and provide customer service and billing.

One of the implementation actions of the City of Benicia's Climate Action Plan is to evaluate the feasibility of the City participating in a CCA. The City is considering joining Marin Clean Energy (MCE), a not-for-profit, community based agency that offers 50-100% renewable (solar, wind, biomass/waste, geothermal) electricity choices.

The City Council will be conducting a workshop for Benicia residents and business owners to learn and discuss what these new choices would mean to our community. A panel of subject experts will be present to provide information on the issues a city should consider before joining a CCA.
