

Rules for Coed Doubles Volleyball



Regulation USA Volleyball Rules apply except as noted below:

- Team must consist of one male and one female.
 - * The roster may include a maximum of 3 official players, and may include up to 2 additional players noted as subs.
 - * At least 1 of the 3 official players MUST play in every game of every match.
 - * Only 1 sub is permitted per match.
- Nets will be set at men's height.
- There shall be only 2 positions on the court—right and left half areas.
- Service shall be made from any position behind the end line.
 - * The “let” serve is considered a legal serve
- Open hand tipping is illegal: Players may not redirect or push the ball with an open hand. Knuckles are allowed.
- A two hand set directed over the net must land beyond the 10 foot attack line. Penalty—point/sideout.
- Teams will be required to officiate games. Player-officials will resolve disputes, keep score and record results, and make final decisions on judgement calls. Players on the court are expected to follow honor code when calling faults.
- Each match during pool play will consist of 2 games to 15, with a cap of 17, rally scoring. A team must win by 2. If score is tied at 16-16, first team to 17 wins.
- Final seedings to advance to double elimination tournament will be based on pool play win/loss record.
- League is only 5 weeks in length so each team will play multiple matches each night.
- Double Elim Tournament will take place over the course of two nights. Teams should be prepared to play multiple matches each night during the tournament.
- For tournament play, game will be 1 game to 25 with no cap. Team must win by 2 points.
