Q: How do I register to vote?

- Voter registration applications can be obtained at the following locations:

Q: Where is my polling location?

- Due to the current Covid-19 situation, voters are encouraged to Vote By Mail (VBM). All voters will receive a VBM ballot for the 11/3/2020 Election. It is not mandatory, however, to avoid long lines at the polling locations, it is encouraged.

Q: Can I drop my Vote By Mail Ballot off at a polling location?

- Yes you can. You can drop your ballot off at any polling location, the Solano County Registrar of Voters office, or in the secure ballot box located in the Benicia City Clerk's Office, 250 East L Street, Benicia, Ca. 94510 up until 4:00 p.m. on the afternoon of the election.
