## New Organics Services

State Law AB1826 required some businesses to have organics in 2016. All businesses with 4 yards or more of trash per week will be required to have organics in 2019. Organics waste is food scraps, landscaping debris and food soiled paper.

- Food waste recycling converts local food waste to compost.
- Participants include restaurants, schools, employee cafeterias and other food waste generators.
- Excellent educational materials and training available.
- Kitchen containers available at no additional charge.
- Fee for service based on container size. Less food in the trash can result in a smaller trash container and bill.

# Hazardous

Electronics contain heavy metals and other toxic chemicals and must be disposed of properly. It is illegal to place these items in the trash.

Republic Services offers free electronic waste pickups for small quantities, less than 50 pounds. To request an electronic waste pickup, call Customer Service at (707) 747-0608.



Many common items such as fluorescent lamps and tubes, batteries, and ballasts, contain mercury, heavy metals, and other toxic chemicals and can't go in the trash. Republic Services offers universal waste collection for mercury-containing items through Mail-Back kits for smaller generators of universal waste, or through our "Pack-Up & Pick-Up" program for large generators of universal waste. Mixed Plastics, Metal, Glass, and Paper, Shrinkwrap and Plastic Bags (bag together in clear plastic bag-no loose material)



**NO**

Food Scraps, Garbage, Green Waste, Styrofoam, Hot Ashes, Hazardous Waste, Batteries or Electronics, Wood



# Organics



**YES**

Yard Trimmings, Fruits, Breads, Vegetables, Food Soiled Paper, Dairy Products, Meat, Seafood (including bones and shells)



**NO**

Plastic, Glass, Metal



Larger organics carts are available if only recycling yard waste.
