Solano County's second large-scale COVID-19 vaccination clinic will be held 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Friday February 12th and Saturday February 13th in Vallejo, thanks to a partnership between Solano County Public Health, Kaiser Permanente, NorthBay Healthcare, Partnership HealthPlan of California, Medic Ambulance and Touro University California. Solano County Public Health is providing the vaccine and will schedule appointments for community members; and the partner organizations are providing staff to administer vaccinations and manage logistics.

Vaccinations are available by appointment only for 4,000 Solano County residents who meet the eligibility requirements. This currently includes health care workers, first responders, and Solano County residents over the age of 75. Vaccination appointments are open to all those who are in an eligible tier, regardless of where they receive medical care.

Vaccinations will be provided in Exposition Hall on the Solano County Fairgrounds in Vallejo. Those who fall into an eligible tier may make an appointment using the links below. The person signing up for their first dose would automatically be signed up for their second dose exactly four weeks from the date of first dose. Due to limited space, access to the facility will be for individuals being vaccinated (exceptions will be considered on a case by case basis).
